

## CALCULATING AREAS FOR RETAINING WALL BLOCKS

Information Sheet – compliments of Heritage Building Products

It's easy to follow these three steps to calculate the **number of blocks** you will need for your retaining wall.

If you are having difficulty please don't hesitate to **contact us**.

- Step 1    The length of the wall divided by the length of the block equals the number of blocks in one row.
- Step 2    The height of the wall divided by the height of the block equals the number of rows in the wall.
- Step 3    The number of blocks per row multiplied by the number of rows in the wall equals the total number of blocks.

**Note:**    To calculate the total wall height: add buried block plus above grade wall height.
